All parties having cases in the categories namely; Matrimonial Disputes, Accident Claims, Domestic Violence, Cheque Bounce, Commercial Dispute, Service Matters, Criminal Compoundable, Consumer Dispute, Debt Recovery, Partition, Eviction, Land Acquisition and other suitable civil cases, who have received notice of their matter being referred for Mediation may kindly participate in the said mediation drive.

Therefore, all parties having cases under such categories, which are at present pending in the High Court of Meghalaya, District Courts, District Council Courts, may kindly explore the possibility for taking up the matter in the said Mediation drive.
