PRESS NOTE

The Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of the Electoral Roll is progressing steadily across Ri Bhoi District under the supervision of the District Election Officer, Ri Bhoi District.

As on 23rd July 2026 at 05.00 PM, a total of 2,05,517 Enumeration Forms (EFs) have been distributed across the district, accounting for 99.89% of the total electors and a total of 1,54,799 Enumeration Forms (EFs) have been digitised across the district, accounting for 78.41% of the total electors.

The Special Intensive Revision (SIR) exercise is progressing smoothly across the district. Significant progress has been achieved in both EF distribution and digitisation, and the figures are improving on a daily basis.

As part of SVEEP initiative for SIR and in order to cause widespread awareness and publicity, a Street Play was held on the 23rd July 2026 at 1:00 PM at Umsning Market in collaboration with the Electoral Literacy Club, Balawan College, Umsning. The programme was conducted with the objective of creating awareness among the general public on the importance of electoral registration, verification of electoral details, and active participation in the electoral process. The Street Play, performed by members of Electoral Literacy Club, Balawan College, Umsning effectively conveyed key messages on voter registration, the significance of maintaining an error-free electoral roll, and the responsibilities of citizens in strengthening democracy.

The District Election Office has observed encouraging cooperation from the electors, who have actively participated in the revision process by providing the required information and documents to facilitate the preparation of an accurate and error-free electoral roll. Based on the current pace of work and the commitment of all stakeholders, the district is confident of achieving the targets within the timeline prescribed by the Election Commission of India.
