ORDER

Whereas, it is observed that the number of COVID-19 cases in the State continues to rise sharply and hospital bed occupancy is nearing saturation;

Therefore, in supersession to all orders issued in respect of Containment Measures in the State, the following shall be enforced in the State w.e.f. 31st May, 2021 until further orders.

Entire State:

- Political, public, social and religious gatherings are not permitted including conferences, meetings and trainings
- Entry of tourists from outside the State shall not be permitted and all tourist spots shall remain closed.
- 3. Sports activities are not permitted.
- 4. Inter-State movement of persons shall be restricted. This shall not apply for transit vehicles of Assam / Tripura / Manipur / Mizoram.
- 5. International Border Trade shall be regulated by the Deputy Commissioners.

East Khasi Hills District:

- 6. Lockdown shall be extended in East Khasi Hills District till 5:00 AM of 7th June, 2021.
- 7. The Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District shall make suitable arrangements for availability of essential commodities in the localities on need basis.
- Home Delivery Services are permitted subject to prior permission and regulation by the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District.
- 9. Inter-district movement of persons from and to East Khasi Hills District shall be restricted.
- 10. All Central Government offices other than those notified by Home (Political) Department vide Notification No. POL.117/2020/Pt.II/136, dated 28-05-2021 shall remain closed.
- 11. All State Government offices other than those notified by Personnel & A.R (A) Department vide Notification No. PER.62/2020/57, dated 28-05-2021 shall remain closed.
- 12. State Bank of India, Main Branch, Laitumkhrah Branch and Secretariat Branch shall function with limited staff for the purpose of government transactions only.
- 13. All other Banks are permitted to open on 31st May, 2021 and 1st June, 2021 with limited staff for the purpose of urgent transactions only. They shall close by 4:00 PM.
- 14. All Post Offices are permitted to open on 2nd, 3rd and 4th June, 2021 with limited staff.
- Ecommerce activities and courier services are permitted subject to regulation by the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District.
- Hardware Stores are permitted to open on need-basis with prior permission of the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills.
- 17. In-situ Construction works for Government Projects that does not involve movement of labour are permitted with due intimation to the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District. In-situ Construction works of Private Projects that does not involve movement of labour are permitted subject to prior permission and regulation of the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills.
- 18. Funeral gathering to be restricted to 10 persons with prior permission of the Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills.
- 19. Weddings are not permitted.

Exemptions:

- 1. Health services including emergency services and vaccination.
- 2. Medicines and Pharmaceuticals.
- 3. Movement of Essential goods.

- Persons travelling on Essential Government Duty viz.,
 - Medical Teams and officials on COVID-19 Duty
 - b. Police, Security and Armed Forces
 - c. Civil Defence and Home Guards
 - d. Fire and Emergency Services
 - e. Electricity
 - f. Water Supply
 - g. Municipal Services
 - h. Public Distribution System
 - i. Information and Public Relations
 - j. Telecommunication Services
- 5. Print & Electronic Media.
- 6. Farming activities in rural areas (including betel nut and betel leaf)
- 7. MGNREGA activities in rural areas.

Other Districts:

Deputy Commissioners / SDO (Civil) are authorised to impose restrictions in their district / subdivision depending on local situation.

All permitted activities are subject to strict compliance to the guidelines and the social distancing protocols issued by the Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Meghalaya.
