App-Based Government Job Coaching to Support Thousands of Ri Bhoi Youth

Nongpoh, February 5: In a significant initiative by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Ri Bhoi District, nearly 7,000 job-seeking youths from the district are set to benefit from a special coaching programme aimed at helping them prepare for various government recruitment examinations at both the State and Central levels.

The programme, titled App-Based Coaching for Government Jobs, will be implemented through a mobile application. Under this initiative, participating candidates will be required to pay only ₹100 per month, while the remaining cost of ₹400 will be subsidised by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner with financial support from NITI Aayog.

Speaking to the media, Deputy Commissioner Ri Bhoi, Shri. Abhilash Baranwal, IAS, along with Additional Deputy Commissioner, Shri Eric Dkhar, informed that the coaching programme is exclusively meant for youths from Ri Bhoi District who have passed Class XII. They further stated that the programme offers multiple benefits, including online and live coaching sessions, recorded classes, and comprehensive coverage of various subjects relevant to competitive examinations. Emphasising its importance, the officials urged eligible job aspirants to make full use of this golden opportunity to enhance their chances of securing government employment.
