Rah-Veer (Good Samaritan Scheme)

- Rah Veer is a scheme that provides a Cash Award to the Good Samaritan who save life of victims involved in serious road accident.
- The Award recognizes individuals who provide immediate assistance by rushing the victims to Hospitals or Trauma Care Centre.
- The main objective of the scheme is to motivate the general public through awards and certificates to help the road accident victims in emergency situation.
- 4. Serious Road Accident defined as:
 - i) Major surgery involved
 - ii) Minimum 3 (three) days of hospitalization
 - iii) Brain injuries
 - iv) Spinal Cord injuries.
 - v) Death of the victim during treatment.
- 5. The amount is ₹ 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) only per incident. If one Rah-Veer saves life of one or more victims of a single serious accident involving a Motor Vehicle the amount will be ₹ 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) only. If more than one Rah Veer save life of one victim of a serious accident, ₹25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) only will be divided equally among them. If more than one Rah-Veer saves life of more than one victims of serious road accident, the amount of award will be ₹ 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty five thousand) only per victim.
- 6. An individual Rah-Veer can be awarded maximum 5 times in a year.
