Review Meeting on the Implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission Schemes Held in Nongstoin

Nongstoin, August 6: A review meeting on the overall implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) schemes in West Khasi Hills District was held today at the Conference Hall, Office of the Deputy Commissioner, Nongstoin.

The meeting was chaired by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-Chairperson, Smti. Hema Nayak, IAS, District Water Mission (JJM), West Khasi Hills District, and attended by members of the District Water Mission, officials from the Public Health Engineering (PHE) Department, and other concerned departments.



During the meeting, a detailed review was undertaken on the progress of various components of the Jal Jeevan Mission. Discussions focused on the progress of Household Tap Water Connections, water supply coverage in schools and Anganwadi Centres (AWCs), implementation of Har Ghar Jal, the Sujalam Bharat App, Jal Seva Aankalan, District Technical Unit (DTU) Operationalization, District Improvement Plan, District Source Sustainability Committee, support activities, and Water Quality Testing.



The members also deliberated on the issues and challenges being faced during the implementation of the schemes and discussed measures to expedite the execution of works to ensure timely achievement of the mission's objectives. Other related matters concerning the effective implementation of Jal Jeevan Mission in the district were also taken up for discussion.
