**Chairman of the Meghalaya State Food Commission**


The Regional Camp was organised by the Deputy Commissioner (Supply) of East Khasi Hills District in collaboration with the office of the Meghalaya State Food Commission on the 9<sup>th</sup> of March, 2026 at Shillong. Shri. D. P. Wahlang, IAS (Retd.), Chairman of the Meghalaya State Food Commission, honoured the event as the Chief Guest, accompanied by Dr. M. Tyngkan, a Member, and Shri. I W. Ingty, IAS (Retd.) as the Member Secretary, present on the dais.



Shri. D. P. Wahlang, the Chairman of the Meghalaya State Food Commission, emphasized the role of the Meghalaya State Food Commission which is in overseeing the implementation of food security schemes across various departments, including Food & Civil Supplies, which manages the Public Distribution System (PDS), Education, which supervises PM-POSHAN, and Social Welfare, which responsible for Anganwadi Centre and also to ensure that no individual goes hungry or is deprived of food.

During his address at the regional camp on Monday, he urged individuals to approach the Commission with any grievances. Should any issue regarding grievance redressal remain unresolved at the Vigilance Committee, District level, or even within the Directorate of Food and Civil Supplies, the Commission is available to assist and guarantee that no eligible individual is denied access to food.
