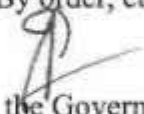

The functions of the Board will be as defined in Section 17 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 and Section 17 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

The Meetings of the Board shall be governed by Rule 3-19 of Chapter II of the Rules framed under the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974. The Board shall meet at least once in every three months and shall observe the Rules of Procedure with regard to the transaction of business at its meetings as may be prescribed or at such time as the Chairman think fit to convene the meeting for transacting any business of urgent nature as defined in Section 8 of the said Act.

A copy of the proceedings of the Meetings should be forwarded to the State Government regularly.

The Headquarter of the Board shall be at Shillong.

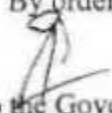
