## **NOTIFICATION**

NO.FOR.24/2021/41:- In accordance with the provisions of Section 36 C of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972(as amended upto 2006), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to declare the Community Forest of Teptepa Village in South Garo Hills District, as a Community Reserve to be known as the "Teptepa Community Reserve" with immediate effect as per the schedule of boundaries indicated below:

Schedule of Boundaries:-

NORTH: The northern boundary starts from point No. 1 at 25°° 12' 45.063" N 90° 53' 0.608" E then it proceeds in Eastern direction along the Do.gep Dara till it reaches point No. 2 at 25° 12' 42.330" N 90° 53' 5.280" E then it continue run along the same direction (Do.gep Dara) then to point No. 3 at 25° 12' 37.913" N 90° 53' 11.231" E, point No. 4 at 25° 12' 34.240" N 90° 53' 14.760" E then to point No. 5 at 25° 12' 31.527" N 90° 53' 19.892" E, point No. 6 at 25° 12' 27.865" N 90° 53' 25.209" E, point No. 7 at 25° 12' 24.710" N 90° 53' 27.550" E, point No. 8 at 25° 12' 25.147" N 90° 53' 29.844" E, point No. 9 at 25° 12' 23.990" N 90° 53' 35.410" E, point No. 10 at 25° 12' 20.974" N 90° 53' 43.613" E till it reaches point No. 11 at 25° 12' 18.870" N 90° 53' 48.100" E.

**EAST**: Eastern boundary starts from point No. 11 at 25° 12' 18.870" N 90° 53' 48.100" E then it proceeds in South Western direction along the Mahadeo River through point No. 12 at 25° 12' 16.210" N 90° 53' 49.160" E, point No. 13 at 25° 12' 11.195" N 90° 53' 43.023" E, point No. 14 at 25° 12' 6.567" N 90° 53' 37.559" E, till it reaches point No. 15 at 25° 12' 1.630" N 90° 53' 35.210" E. From the point No. 15, the boundary proceeds in South Eastern direction along the same river (Mahadeo River) through point No. 16 at 25° 11' 59.600" N 90° 53' 36.740" E, point No. 17 at 25° 11' 57.230" N 90° 53' 43.350" E, point No. 18 at 25° 11' 53.430" N 90° 53' 48.500" E till it reaches point No. 19 at 25° 11' 51.610" N 90° 53' 48.730" E.

**SOUTH:** Southern boundary starts from point No. 19 at 25° 11′ 51.610″N 90° 53′ 48.730″E then it continue run along the same River in Western direction through point No. 20 at 25° 11′ 47.560″ N 90° 53′ 42.320″ E, point No. 21 at 25° 11′ 44.830″ N 90° 53′ 33.300″ E, point No. 22 at 25° 11′ 45.380″ N 90° 53′ 20.680″ E till it reaches point No. 23 at 25° 11′ 44.080″ N 90° 53′ 18.810″ E. From the point No. 23, it proceeds in North Western direction along the Himdanggi Dara till it reaches point No. 24 at 25° 11′ 50.260″ N 90° 53′ 14.460″ E then it continue run along the same direction (Himdanggi Dara) through point No. 25 at 25° 11′ 53.726″ N 90° 53′ 13.027″ E till it reaches point No. 26 at 25° 11′ 55.525″ N 90° 53′ 9.469″ E. From the point No. 26, it proceeds in Western direction along the boundary of the said land (Himdanggi Dara) till it reaches point No. 27 at 25° 11′ 54.460″ N 90° 53′ 3.900″ E.

From the point No. 33, the boundary it proceeds towards Western direction along the Teptepa Nokma Land boundary till it reaches point No. 34 at 25° 12' 22.872" N 90° 53' 5.460" E and point No. 35 at 25° 12' 21.630" N 90° 53' 3.680" E then it continue run along the same A'king Land boundary towards West through point No. 36 at 25° 12' 25.828" N 90° 52' 58.820" E, point No. 37 at 25° 12' 31.350" N 90° 52' 56.320" E, point No. 38 at 25° 12' 37.417" N 90° 52' 56.378" E, point No. 39 at 25° 12' 42.812" N 90° 52' 56.689"E till it reaches starting of the Northern boundary at point No.1 at 25° 12' 45.063" N 90° 53' 0.608" E.
