1. The Committee will examine the current rates of COVID-19 treatment in different hospitals. It will also assess how the MHIS packages are being utilized by SECC (BPL) beneficiaries and other MHIS beneficiaries.
2. The Committee will come up with recommendation on the reasonable cost of providing quality medical care to the COVID-19 patients who are admitted in the Private Hospitals taking into consideration the actual costs incurred in providing care service and also the additional investments created by the hospitals to expand the bed capacity (Oxygen service, ICUs, Ventilators) to meet the surge capacity during the pandemic.
