Such retention shall be extended annually on payment of retention fee of <u>Rs.15000/- (Rupees fifteen thousand) only every year</u>. If the owner fails to retain the registration number annually, the same will automatically become the property of the Government.

Retention fee will not be applicable for Government vehicles.
