FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE

01. To select schemes which are relevant to be implemented in the border areas either directly by the Border Areas Development Department or by the implementing Departments under this Programme of Special Central Assistance within the allocated amounts.
02. To oversee the Utilisation of grant sanctioned to implementing Departments/Organisations/Institutions/individual. The Committee may also consider State Plan Schemes separately as and when allocations are made.
03. The Committee shall exercise such powers and functions as stipulated by the Government from time to time.
04. All schemes proposed should be located within the notified border villages.
05. The Committee shall meet at least once in a year but positively in December to finalise the schemes for the following year.
06. The headquarter of the Committee is at Tura/Baghmara.
07. The presence of 6 (six) members (including the chairman) shall constitute the quorum.
08. Notices for the meeting should be circulated at least 15 (fifteen) days in advance, before the date of the meeting.
09. The Committee shall be guided by the sector-wise allocation of fund as shown in the Annexure 'A' for the schemes under the Special Central Assistance and as per allocation of fund earmarked by the Director, Border Areas Development, Meghalaya, from time to time for the schemes under the State Plan.
10. If the MLA happens to be the Minister, he may authorise his representative (in writing to the chairman) to attend the meeting on his behalf.
11. The Committee shall be convened by the Member-Secretary with approval of the chairman.
