FUNCTIONS OF THE COMMITTEE:

01. To select schemes which are relevant to be implemented in the border areas either directly by the Border Areas Development Department or by the implementing Departments under this programme of Special Central Assistance within the allocated amounts.
02. To oversee the Utilisation of grant sanctioned to implementing Departments/Organisations/Institutions/individual. The Committee may also consider State Plan Schemes separately as and when allocations are made.
03. The Committee shall exercise such powers and functions as stipulated by the Government from time to time.
