No.PER.46/2022/24 :- The instructions contained in this Department's Office Memorandum No.PER.46/2022/23, Dated 11.03.2024, pertaining to the Applicability of Central Service /State Service Leave Rules to Officers Reemployed in Government Service after Retirement/Superannuation stands cancelled in view of the Government of India's decision under **Rule 26 of the A.I.S. (DCRB) Rules, 1958**, which is quoted below:-

"Indian Administrative/Police Service Officers are treated as non-cadre officers after their retirement. Their re-employment in cadre posts shall be regulated by rule 9 of Indian Administrative/Police Service (Cadre) Rules, 1954. As regards reemployment in non-cadre posts, State government rules will apply."
