Discontinuation of interview for Group D posts.

The Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to order that there shall be no interview, henceforth, in respect of recruitment to Group D posts in the Government of Meghalaya. The Departmental Selection Committees, District Selection Committees or any other Recruitment Agencies/Boards which undertakes recruitment for the Group D posts shall, henceforth, comply with this direction. In those cases pertaining to Group D posts, where Recruitment Rules specify the process of selection which includes conduct of interview, the Departments concerned will take necessary steps to carry out the requisite amendment to the Recruitment Rules immediately.

However, this direction will not be applicable to appointments on contractual basis or daily wage basis. Further, it is clarified that if there are existing skill tests/physical tests that are necessary for any Group D posts, they may continue as they are different from interviews.

The directions of this Office Memorandum will take effect w.e.f 1st October, 2025.
