Function of the Block Level Child Welfare and Protection Committee:

- 1. The Block Level Child Welfare and Protection Committee (VLCWPC) shall monitor the implementation of Mission Vatsalya Scheme at the Block level.
- 2. Ensuring safe public spaces and child friendly atmosphere in the villages.
- 3. Advise all Village Head Council to include in Village Level Development Plan (VLDP) provision for support to women and child related activities.
- 4. Ensure provision of municipal budget for women and children in urban ward areas.
- 5. Inspection and assessment of implementation of schemes and programs for children in the area.
- 6. To ensure survey of all children with special needs likely to be in difficult circumstances, orphans, street children etc., and take appropriate actions so that no child is left behind.
- 7. To discuss the status of vulnerable children who are missing, school drop-outs, trafficked victims, migrant children, beggars, orphan, and take appropriate action for their wellbeing.
- 8. To hold special campaigns and awareness drives for promoting child rights and ensuring child protection.
- 9. Ensure support to DCPUs, CWCs, JJBs and SJPUs in carrying out their roles under Juvenile Justice Act/Rules.
- 10. To boost volunteerism in the area of Juvenile Justice and Child Protection.
- 11. To roll out convergent activities fostering rehabilitation and social re-integration of children such as career counselling, skill training enrolment, apprenticeship enrolment, sports clubs/camps, etc.
- 12. Reporting to District Magistrate through DCPU regarding vulnerability hotspots and strategy devised for addressing it.
- 13. To organize Bal Panchayats and appoint Child Ambassadors in Villages from amongst children in schools etc.; and lay down necessary inputs from children on various issues before Gram Panchayats for appropriate action.
