In order to facilitate and simplify the reimbursement of claims of the pensioners including members of their families, the Governor of Meghalaya is please of decide that the concerned authorities which have been invested with the powers to sanction reimbursement of medical claims vide Office Memorandum No.Health.136/80/PF/42, dated 5.8.18982, shall also be allowed to operate the said head of account for the purposes mentioned above.
