No. LJ(A) 77/2000/207- For the purpose of the Rules for the Administration of Justice and Police in the Khasi and Jaintia Hills, 1937 and of the Khasi Syiemship (Administration of Justice) Order, 1950, the Governor of Meghalaya, with the approval of the Gauhati High Court, is pleased to appoint the following Judicial Officers, as the Assistant to Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District and further under rule 17 and paragraph 4(2) of the aforesaid rules and orders, invest them with the powers of the Judicial Magistrate of the First Class as defined in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 within the East Khasi Hills District excluding Sohra (Civil) Sub-Division with immediate effect. However, any appeal, from Sohra (Civil) Sub-Division will lie with the court of Additional Deputy Commissioner, (District & Sessions Judge) Shillong.

It is further informed that this Government has accepted the proposal of the Administrative Committee Meeting held on 25-05-2011 for East Khasi Hills District as first phase for Separation of Judiciary from Executive and to state as follows,-
  - a. All Civil and Criminal cases requiring judicial adjudication and pending before the Assistant to Deputy Commissioner, Shillong shall stand automatically transferred to the Assistant to Deputy Commissioner, Shillong (aforementioned Judicial Officers) from the date of issue of this notification.
  - b. All appeals from orders passed by the Assistant to the Deputy Commissioner shall lie only to the Additional Deputy Commissioner (District and Sessions Judge) Shillong from the date of issue of this notification.
