No. LJ (A) 23/85/530 – In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 234 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Meghalaya in consultation with the Gauhati High Court is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Meghalaya Judicial Service Rules, 2006, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules) namely:-

1. (1) These Rules may be called the Meghalaya Judicial Service (Amendment) Rules, 2012.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of Rule 8: In the principal rules, after the table to the proviso to rule 8, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

“Provided further that where the Chief Justice is of the opinion that the operation of any rule causes undue hardship in a particular case, he may by order relax the requirement of that rule to such extent and subject to such conditions as he may deem necessary.”

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
