No.PDS.70/2013/68 - In partial modification to this Department's Notification No.PDS. 70/2013/40 dt. 20/05/2014, the Governor of Meghalaya is hereby pleased to modify certain provisions of the duly constituted Prisons Recruitment Board (PRB) for recruitment to the post of Assistant Jailor, Warders, Naiks, Drivers, Mechanics, Plumbers, Cooks and Followers though a transparent recruitment process based on tested system and procedures as below:

- 1. The Prisons Recruitment Board shall be read as with the following members:-
 - (i) Director General of Prisons, Meghalaya, Shillong Chairman.
 - (ii) Asstt. Inspector General, Prisons, Meghalaya, Shillong Member Secretary.
 - (iii) Representative from Personnel & A.R. Department (Not below the rank of Under Secretary) Member
 - (iv) Representative from Finance Department (Not below the rank of Under Secretary) Member
 - (v) Any other members who may be co opted by the DG Prisons from the rank of SP and below.
- 16. Timing Equipment It shall stand omitted.
- 17. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) It shall be read as:
- 17.1. The Physical Efficiency Test shall carry a Maximum of 100 marks which will be conducted in the traditional method under video recording.
- 17.2. Candidates would be required to register themselves at the earmarked registration counters where their biometric data will also be recorded.
- 17.3 The Events in the Physical Efficiency Tests will consist of an 800 metres race for Male candidates and a 500 metres race for Female candidates and shall carry marks as indicated below:
- 17.4 Male candidates will be required to qualify in an 800 metres race in 10 minutes or less, marks assigned are as follows:

17.5 Female candidates will be required to qualify in a 500 metres race in 10 minutes or less, marks assigned are as follows:

Time (In minutes)		[9.01 to 10.00	10.01 and above
Marks	100	90	80	0

- 17.6 The result of those who successfully complete the race within the stipulated time will be printed out by the system which will also generate a daily list of successful Candidates in the PET. Those who do not finish the race within the minimum prescribed time are issued a rejection letter and they will not be allowed to participate in other subsequent recruitment events.
- 17.7 The Recruitment Board will publish the result of the race conducted on each day on the Notice Board or website of the Directorate of Prisons and Meghalaya Government website www.meghalaya.gov.in.
- 17.8 The daily performance of the candidates shall be uploaded into the website of the Prisons Directorate and Meghalaya Govt website.

18. Conduct of Written Examination - It shall be read as:

18.3. The subjects for written examination for recruitment to the post of Assistant Jailors are as follows:-

Paper I: General English - including Precis writing, Essay writing, drafting and questions on grammar	100	60 minutes
Paper-II- Elementary Mathematics, power of reasoning and Elementary Science (Multiple choice/OMR based) (multiple choice / OMR based)	100	60 minutes
Papre III: General Knowledge (Multiple choice/ OMR based)	100	60 minutes

- 19. Preparation of short list of candidates for interview and personality test It shall be read as:
- 19.1. Based on the total marks scored by the candidates in the (i) Physical efficiency tests and (ii) written examination and (iii) bonus marks, the Prisons Recruitment Board shall prepare a short list of candidates for the interview.
- 19.2. The total number of candidates to be called for interview shall be three times the total number of vacancies belonging to each category of candidates based on the reservation policy of the State Government.
- 20. **PERSONALITY TEST-** It shall be read as:
- 20.1. The maximum marks allotted for personality test is 150. Interview shall be done at Shillong and at Tura.
- 22. Medical Test It shall be read as:
- 22.1 Medical tests will be conducted only after an appointment letter is issue.

Physical Efficiency Tests - 300 marks
 Interview cum trade assessment - 150 marks
 Total - 450 marks

32. Physical Efficiency Test (PET) - Para 32.7 stands omitted and it shall be read as:

- 32.1. The Physical Efficiency Test shall carry a maximum of 300 marks which will be conducted in the traditional method under video recording.
- 32.2. Candidates would be required to register themselves at the earmarked registration counters where their biometric data will also be recorded.
- 32.3. The events in the Physical Efficiency Tests will consist of 800 metres race for Male candidates and 500 metres race for Female candidates and shall carry marks as indicated below:
- 32.4 Male candidates will be required to qualify in an 800 metres race in 8 minutes or less, marks assigned are as follows:

32.5 Female candidates will be required to qualify in a 500 metres race in 8 minutes or less, marks assigned are as follows:

- 32.6 Those candidates who do not complete the race within the time as prescribed above, will be eliminated automatically and they will not be allowed to participate in the subsequent events of the recruitment process.
- 32.7 The daily performance of the candidates shall be uploaded into the website of the Prisons Directorate and Meghalaya Govt websites.
- 35. The maximum marks allotted for interview shall be read as 150 instead of 50 (out of a total 450).
