OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject : Check on fraudulent drawal of Travelling Allowance (TA).

The issue regarding alleged fraudulent drawal of Travelling Allowance has received the attention of the Government for sometime. As per Rule 89(VI) of the Meghalaya TA Rules 1985, the Controlling Officer is to scrutinize and satisfy himself/herself that the TA claims are admissible and are in order in all respects before countersigning the TA Bill.

With a view to check fraudulent drawal of TA claims, it is henceforth decided that in all cases of TA claims including Medical TA claims, the TA bills shall be supported by original boarding passes alongwith the tickets in case of air journey, and attested copies of Railway tickets in case of journey by train. No TA bills shall be passed without the aforementioned supporting documents.

This order shall take effect immediately.


