I am to authorise to make payment of this revised rate of Dearness Allowance to the serving Gazetted Officers of the Government of Meghalaya, w.e.f. 01-07-2014 at the rate shown at para 3, below, by production of Bills in respect of the cases of the officers concerned, without insisting on individual Authority from this office. This present rate of dearness Allowance is inclusive of the rate of Dearness Allowance sanctioned earlier vide Finance (PR) Department, Meghalaya, O.M No.F(PR)-47/2009/Pt.I/54 dated. 17.4.2014 and authorised .

2. This authority remains valid till pay slip(s) incorporating the present Dearness Allowance is/are issued by this office in respective cases of the officers.

3. Period payable

Rate of Dearness Allowance

From 1-7-2014

95 % of Basic Pay.

Note:- (i) The payment on account of the Dearness Allowance shall be rounded off the nearest Rupee.  
(ii) The Pay for calculation of the Dearness Allowance shall be as defined in F.R.7(17)(i) of the Meghalaya FR's & SR's 1984.

4. The expenditure on this account shall be debitible to the respective Heads of Accounts from which the officers draw their Salary.
