75th Republic Day, 2024 celebration across the State

Shillong, January 27, 2024: At **Tura**: Chief Minister, Shri Conrad K. Sangma unfurled the National Flag and took the Salute of 11 parade contingents at Matchakolgre L P School Playground, New Tura.

On the occasion, the Chief Guest Conrad Sangma presented the Lifetime Achievement Award to Rodrick D Shira for his outstanding and exceptional achievements, contributions and excellent service to the people of the State and the nation as a whole. An Alumnus of the prestigious IIT Kharagpur in Electronics and Electrical Communication Engineering, he was awarded Gold medal for Electronics in 1967 and started his career in Fertilizer Industries as Process Control Engineer and worked in FCI Sindri and has served in different places in various capacities. Being selected by Public Enterprise Selection Board (PESB) in 1998 he became the Director of Production in the Bongaigaon Refinery and Petrochemicals limited presently Indian Oil Corporation Limited and retired in the same position in 2003. In 2017, he was selected as the First Vice Chancellor of Captain Williamson Sangma's Technical University at Jewilgre by the Government of Meghalaya.
