**PRESS NOTE**

**Special Intensive Revision (SIR), 2026 - Status of Distribution of Enumeration Forms in Meghalaya (as on 30th June, 2026)**

1. The Office of the Chief Electoral Officer, Meghalaya, has commenced the **Special Intensive Revision (SIR), 2026** in accordance with the programme announced by the Election Commission of India. The main objective of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) is to ensure that **"No eligible citizen is left out, while no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll."**
2. As part of the SIR, Booth Level Officers (BLOs) have started **house-to-house visits** across the State from **30th June, 2026** for distribution of Enumeration Forms (EFs) and verification of electoral details.
3. A total of **3,551 Booth Level Officers (BLOs)** has been deployed across the State, and all 3,551 BLOs have been imparted training for the conduct of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR), 2026. In addition, **60 Electoral Registration Officers (EROs), 166 Assistant Electoral Registration Officers (AEROs), and 410 BLO Supervisors** have been appointed & trained to oversee and facilitate the SIR process across Meghalaya.
4. Meghalaya has a total electorate of **23,49,645 electors**, with an average of **662 electors per BLO**. On the first day of the house-to-house campaign, **119,129 Enumeration Forms** were distributed, covering **5.07%** of the total electorate.
5. Among the districts, **South West Garo Hills** recorded the highest coverage with **20.49%** of Enumeration Forms distributed, followed by **North Garo Hills (10.25%), South Garo Hills (6.67%), and West Garo Hills (6.5%)**. **East Khasi Hills**, the district with the largest electorate, distributed **28,006 Enumeration Forms**, accounting for **4.43%** of its electors as on **1<sup>st</sup> July, 2026 at 3 PM**.
6. The house-to-house verification and distribution of Enumeration Forms will continue up to **29th July, 2026**. The activities during this enumeration phase are as follows:
  - Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will distribute, in duplicate the Enumeration Form (EF) to each Elector.
  - BLO will collect back one filled EF while giving acknowledgement on the 2<sup>nd</sup> EF

- No supporting document is to be furnished during the Enumeration Phase
- BLO to slip EF, if house is locked, and make three visit to collect EF
- Alternatively, electors may fill and submit the Enumeration Form online during the Enumeration phase of SIR period through the **ECINET** mobile application (available on the Google Play Store and Apple App Store) or by visiting the <https://ecinet.eci.gov.in/homepage> or Voter Services Portal at <https://voters.eci.gov.in>.
- For the convenience of electors and the general public, the legacy Electoral Roll 2005 prepared during the last Special Intensive Revision (SIR) conducted in 2005 has been made available on the official website of the CEO and the District Administration website. Electors may verify whether their names appear in the legacy Electoral Roll of 2005 through any of the following platforms:

  - ❖ **ECINET** mobile application (available on the Google Play Store and Apple App Store)
  - ❖ Voter Services Portal: <https://voters.eci.gov.in/>
  - ❖ The legacy Electoral Roll 2005 prepared during the last Special Intensive Revision (SIR) conducted in 2005 is also available with the Booth Level Officers (BLOs)
- Electors whose names appear in the legacy Electoral Roll of 2005 are advised to note the relevant particulars, namely **Name, Relative's Name, State Name, District Name, Assembly Constituency (AC) Number, Part Number, and Serial Number**, before filling up the Enumeration Form.
- Electors who have migrated from other States and settled in the district after 2005 may not find their names in the 2005 Electoral Roll of Meghalaya. Such electors are advised to search their details on the Voter Services Portal at <https://voters.eci.gov.in/> or through the **ECINET** mobile application and note the relevant particulars, namely Name, Relative's Name, State Name, District Name, Assembly Constituency (AC) Number, Part Number and Serial Number, as available in the last SIR Electoral Roll of the concerned State (2002/2003/2004/2005, as applicable).
- Electors are advised to keep the above information readily available while filling the Enumeration Form (EF). This will facilitate the accurate and hassle-free completion of the form. **No supporting documents are required to be submitted along with the Enumeration Form.** However, a **recent passport-size photograph** must be pasted on the Enumeration Form or uploaded while submitting the form through the ECINET app online self-enumeration facility.
- In cases where the name of the present elector does not appear in the legacy Electoral Roll of 2005, but the name of their parent(s) or grandparent(s) appears therein, the elector may furnish the relevant details of such parent(s)/grandparent(s) in the Enumeration Form.

- For more information, electors may contact their respective Booth Level Officers (BLOs). The name and contact details of the BLO are displayed at your respective Polling Station. Electors can also book an appointment or request a call with their BLO through the ECINET App, available for download from the Google Play Store and the Apple App Store (iOS). Scan the QR Code below to download the ECINET App.



7. Electors are requested to cooperate with the Booth Level Officers during their visits, carefully fill up the Enumeration Forms, and return the completed forms to the BLOs within the prescribed time.
8. The Office of the Chief Electoral Officer appeals to all eligible electors to actively participate in the Special Intensive Revision to ensure that the Electoral Roll remains accurate, complete and up to date.
