

OFFICE OF SENG SAMLA SHNONG LAITKOR PYLLUN INAUGURATED

Shillong, January 30, 2021: Chairman, Meghalaya State Planning Board and MLA/MDC of Nongkrem Constituency, Shri. Lambor Malngiang today inaugurated the office of the Seng Samla Shnong Laitkor Pyllun at Laitkor, Shillong in the presence of Deputy Commissioner, East Khasi Hills District, Kum. I Laloo.
