PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 163 BNSS.

Whereas it has been brought to the notice of the undersigned through reports from multiple sources including local authorities, village durbars and field inspections that:

- Water bodies such as rivers, streams, ponds, and drinking water sources within the jurisdiction of Pynursla Civil Sub-Division, Pynursla, are being polluted, resulting in grave impacts on the tributaries feeding the Umngot River.
- And whereas, such pollution is caused by the discharge of waste, dumping of plastics, construction debris, washing of vehicles, and other harmful activities;
- And that these activities pose a serious threat to public health, aquatic ecology, drinking water safety, and environmental sustainability;

And whereas such acts amount to public nuisance and imminent danger to the community, requiring immediate preventive measures;

And whereas immediate measures are required under section 163 BNSS 2023 to prevent public nuisance and environmental danger;

Now, therefore, I, Smti. E. L. Warjri, MCS, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Pynursla Civil Sub-Division, Pynursla in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under section 163 BNSS do hereby order that:

- No person or entity or company or any industry shall dump waste, sewage, plastics, chemicals, construction debris, or any pollutant into any water bodies.
- 2. Washing of vehicles, clothes, or equipment in public water bodies is strictly prohibited.
- 3. Discharge of industrial or commercial effluents into natural water bodies is banned.
