


PRESS RELEASE

THE MEMBERSHIP POLICY OF THE SCOUTS & GUIDES
OF INDIA
1. The purpose of this policy is to ensure that the
Scouts and Guides of India are able to attract and
retain a sufficient number of members to enable them
to carry out their activities effectively and efficiently.
2. The policy shall be based on the following principles:
(a) The Scouts and Guides of India shall be open to
all young people of Indian origin, regardless of their
religion, caste, creed, or social status.
(b) The Scouts and Guides of India shall be open to
all young people who are between the ages of 10 and
18 years.
(c) The Scouts and Guides of India shall be open to
all young people who are physically fit and of good
character.
(d) The Scouts and Guides of India shall be open to
all young people who are willing to accept the Scout
Law and the Scout Oath.
