Jowai Police recovered 47 Lost/Stolen Mobile Phones Using Technology

In a significant technology-driven policing initiative, Jowai Police have successfully traced and recovered 47 lost/stolen mobile phones, which have been handed over to their legitimate owners following due verification and procedure.

The District Police had received complaints from residents regarding lost or stolen mobile phones over a period of time. Using various technological tools and investigative techniques, police teams were able to trace and recover the devices from different locations within and outside the district, including locations outside the state.



Investigation is underway to establish the chain of persons through whom these mobile phones changed hands and to ascertain how the devices ended up at various locations. Necessary legal action will be taken against those found involved, as per law.

The District Police cautions the public against purchasing used mobile phones from unknown or unauthorised persons without verifying their authenticity and ownership, as such devices may be stolen property.

Efforts are continuing to trace and recover more lost/stolen mobile phones and reunite them with their legitimate owners.
