TMB to conduct Rabies Vaccination Drive in Tura on Sept 28

Tura, September 24, 2026: The Tura Municipal Board (TMB) has informed all residents of Tura that World Rabies Day 2026 will be observed on September 28 under the global theme “Stronger Together,” highlighting the One Health approach that links human, animal and environmental health.

As part of the observance, a Rabies Vaccination Drive will be conducted in collaboration with the District AH & Veterinary department, Tura. The initiative follows a recent Joint Field Survey conducted within the Tura Municipal Area, which revealed that there are no feral or unowned dogs in Tura, with all free-roaming canines having identifiable caretakers, community guardians or household owners.

The findings underscore the collective responsibility of the community in ensuring the health and welfare of animals and present a unique opportunity to work towards eliminating the threat of rabies in Tura through responsible pet ownership and timely vaccination.

All pet owners in Tura and adjoining areas are urged to bring their dogs and cats above three months of age for anti-rabies vaccination on September 28, 2026 (Monday) at the State Veterinary Dispensary, Brahminpara, Tura, from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM.

The Tura Municipal Board has appealed to all residents and pet owners to actively participate in the vaccination drive and cooperate in maintaining Tura as a rabies-free and safe zone for everyone.
