Education Minister Inaugurates

New Building of Mawmihthied RMSA Secondary School, Sohra

Sohra, March 23: Education Minister Shri. Lakhmen Rymbui on 23rd March 2026 inaugurated the newly constructed building of Mawmihthied RMSA Secondary School in East Khasi Hills district.
