Ministry of Rural Development select Meghalaya to Showcase Inter-Departmental Convergence Best Practices at a Regional Workshop in Bangalore, Karnataka

In a significant recognition of its innovative approach to addressing critical issues in Food, Nutrition, Health, and Wash (FNHW) interventions; Meghalaya was selected to present its best practices for Inter-Departmental Convergence at a workshop organized by the Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India. The event is attended by representatives from over 19 states and took place in Bangalore Karnataka.

The Chief Operating Officer of Meghalaya State Rural Livelihoods Society (MSRLS), Shri.
