Speaker Inspects Progress of New Meghalaya Legislative Assembly Building at Mawdiangdiang

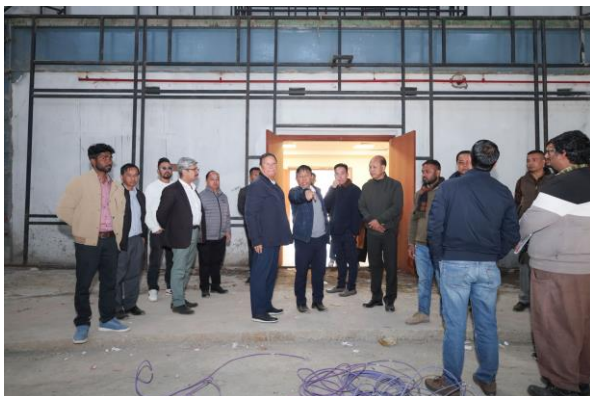
Pre-Christmas Celebrations to Take Place on 19 December 2025

Shillong, 11-12-2025: The Hon'ble Speaker of the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly, Shri Thomas A. Sangma, on Thursday conducted a detailed inspection of the upcoming Assembly building complex at Mawdiangdiang, accompanied by the Deputy Speaker and senior officials from various departments.



During the visit, the Speaker reviewed the ongoing works in preparation for the Pre-Christmas celebration scheduled for December 19, which will be held at the new premises for the first time. He noted that the team assessed overall progress and confirmed that necessary arrangements are moving forward as planned.

A significant part of the inspection focused on the power supply infrastructure being implemented by the Meghalaya Energy Corporation Limited (MeECL). The Speaker informed that constructive discussions were held with MeECL officials to explore ways to expedite the connection of the main power line to the complex at the earliest possible time.



The delegation also examined issues related to additional land requirements, in coordination with officials of the Urban Affairs Department, and carried out field inspections as part of the review.



Expressing satisfaction with the progress, Shri Sangma stated that the team is pleased with the pace and quality of work on the project. He reiterated confidence that construction will be completed within the timeline recommended by the High-Powered Committee (HPC).

The inspection team included Deputy Speaker of the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly Shri Limison D. Sangma, Commissioner & Secretary Shri Andrew Simons, Secretary Shri Malthus S. Sangma of the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly, the Executive Engineer, Technical Adviser to the Assembly, officials of MeECL, and representatives from the Urban Affairs Department.

It may be recalled that the Speaker recently reaffirmed that the main Assembly Hall is slated for completion by June 2026, after which Assembly sessions will be convened at the new complex.
