Deputy Speaker Attends 86th All India Presiding Officers' Conference in Lucknow

Shillong, January 19, 2026: The Deputy Speaker of the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly, Shri Limison D. The three-day conference commenced on Monday and will continue till January 21, 2026.

The conference will conclude on January 21, 2026, with the Valedictory Address by Lok Sabha Speaker Shri Om Birla.
