PRESS RELEASE

Due to the increase in prices of essential commodities at source and based on the challans considering the freight and other charges till Shillong, the wholesale and the retail prices of rice common, sugar, masoor dal, gram dal, mustard oil, edible oil, sun flower oil and potato has been refixed as on 21st April, 2021.

Order has been given to the open market traders dealing in essential commodities to refrain from hoarding of stock which will lead to panic buying and artificial shortage. The Deputy Commissioner (Supply) is monitoring the same on a daily basis to make sure that there is no hoarding/black marketing. Essential food items should not exceed the rates as fixed by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner. Stern action will be taken if found against the defaulters.

As the stock in the market is sufficient and closely being monitored, it is appealed to the consumers to not resort to panic buying.
