

THE MEGHALAYA MINISTERS' (ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (TENTH AMENDMENT) RULES, 1981

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These Rules may be called Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Tenth Amendment) Rules 1981.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of December, 1980.

2. Amendment of Rule 19 of the principal Rules.—In Rule 19 (i) for the existing first proviso to sub-rule (1) the following shall be substituted, namely:

“Provided that in case of journeys not involving night halt full daily allowance will be admissible where the distance travelled is not less than 80 kms. and half of such allowance where the distance is 40 kms. or more but less than 80 kms.”
