No.FEM.32/81/14.—In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 8 and 10 of the Meghalaya Ministers' Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1972 (Act, 4 1972), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following further amendments to the Meghalaya Minister's (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules), namely :—

**THE MEGHALAYA MINISTERS' (ALLOWANCES
AND PRIVILEGES) (THIRTEENTH AMENDMENT)
RULES, 1983.**

1. **Short title and commencement** :—(1) These Rules may be called Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Thirteenth Amendment) Rules, 1983.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 19th April, 1983.

2. **Amendment of Rule 7 of the principal Rules** :—In Clause (i) of Rule 7, for the words "rupees one hundred" occurring therein the words "rupees two hundred" shall be substituted.
