**No. FEM. 106/85.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the section 8 and 10 of the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Salaries) Act, 1972 (Act 4 of 1972), the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following amendments the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules), namely:—

**THE MEGHALAYA MINISTERS' (ALLOWANCES AND  
PRIVILEGES) (SEVENTEENTH AMENDMENT)  
RULES, 1987.**

**1. Short title and commencement:**—(1) These Rules may be called Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Seventeenth Amendment) Rules, 1987.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on and from the 1st April, 1986.

**2. Amendment of Rule 3:**—In rule 3, the full-stop “(.)” at the end of sub-rule (2) shall be deleted and the following shall be inserted thereafter, namely:—

“or within such monetary limit exceeding rupees sixty thousand in exceptional circumstances with the approval of the Chief Minister”.
