No. FEM 9/79/Pt-II/13— In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 8 and 10 of the Meghalaya Ministers' (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1972 (Act 4 of 1972), the Government of Meghalaya is pleased to make the following amendment to the Meghalaya Minister, or (Allowances and Privileges) Rules, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Rules), namely —

THE MEGHALAYA MINISTER'S (ALLOWANCES AND PRIVILEGES) (AMENDMENT) RULES, 1980

1. Short title and commencement—(1) These Rules may be called the Meghalaya Ministers' (Allowances and Privileges) (Amendment) Rules, 1980.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st day of October, 1979.

2. Amendment of Rule 12—In the principal Rules, for the words "the senior grade" occurring in sub-rule (1) of rule 12, the word and numeral "Grade I" shall be substituted.

3. Amendment of Rule 19— In the principal Rules, in Rule 19 for the existing sub-rule (1) except the provisos thereunder, the following shall be substituted, namely—

"A Minister may draw daily allowance at the rate of rupees thirty one per day for each day of travel or halt inside Meghalaya and at double the rate for each day of travel or halt out-side Meghalaya but within the North Eastern Region and at treble the rate for each day of travel or halt outside the North Eastern Region. The daily allowance is admissible only when a Minister spends a night away from headquarters on duty."
